Today I became aware of a possible COVID exposure situation that may affect some members of your child's class. I have been in touch with Dr. Sherry Young at the Health Department who has told me that the classroom can remain open and that there is currently no reason for the classroom to be closed. We will be deep cleaning the classroom this evening: this is something we do every night. Communications with families who may have been directly affected have already occurred.

I know this is unsettling news, but we will continue to work through this together. This class is doing a fantastic job with mask wearing and social distancing. Our faculty and staff rigorously clean, sanitize, and follow detailed safety practices throughout the day. We will remain vigilant and do our best to keep our school family safe and healthy.
