TECHNOLOGY UPDATE

Thanks to funds raised on our *Day of Giving* and the *Around the World Gala*, the following technology upgrades are being purchased to be implemented during the 2018-2019 school year:

An additional mobile iPad lab with 10 iPads!

Apple TV for the gymnasium and the computer lab!

3 document cameras!

Throughout the year, students have visited the computer lab and have utilized the mobile iPad lab to work toward meeting the tiered technology goals below. These goals are integrated into the existing curriculum allowing students to make connections between academic content and technology. Students achieve the desired goal in a meaningful environment that allows for deeper understanding of the content and the technological tool. Students are able to have more interactions with technology with this integrated plan than by having only an isolated 45 minute computer class each week. Additionally, Kindergarten and Pre K students visit the computer lab as a class in order to become familiar with the tools available at SHGS. In addition to other computer activities, students have:

-published documents and presentations using **Microsoft Word, Microsoft Publisher, and PowerPoint.**

-recapped school events, told stories, and helped to create the SHGS promotional video using **iMovie** and apps such as **Story Creator** and **Trailer.**

-made music using **Garage Band** and engaged in interactive learning activities with **ABC Mouse, Kahoot,** and **Splash Math.**

-participated in interactive **Nearpod** lessons on the iPad that enhance learning and encourage the sharing of ideas.

-investigated coding with **Scratch** and **Scratch Junior** apps.

SHGS Technology Goals

- PreK** Student demonstrates age appropriate understanding of basic skills needed to use learning games in lab for computer orientation and comfort.
Student demonstrates age appropriate understanding of the Smartboard as a technological tool for learning.
- K** Student demonstrates age appropriate mastery of the Smartboard.
Student demonstrates age appropriate mastery of computer lab and iPad games as technological tools for learning.
- 1st** Student demonstrates age appropriate keyboarding and beginning writing skills.
- 2nd** Student demonstrates age appropriate keyboarding skills .
Student demonstrates the ability to use technological tools to solve problems, to answer questions through online research that support classroom content, and to produce a written document.
- 3rd** Student demonstrates age appropriate understanding of Microsoft Word to produce written documents related to classroom content.
Student differentiates between technological tools based on task, purpose, and audience for online research supporting multiple document creation.
- 4th** Student demonstrates the transfer knowledge of technology from known skills to unknown skills by using Microsoft Publisher to share current events.
- 5th** Student demonstrates the transfer knowledge of technology from known skills to unknown skills by using PowerPoint or other video/slide programs to share and communicate curriculum content and school events.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES 2018 – 2019

GRADES 1 - 5

Additional supplies may be requested by teachers on the first day of school. Assignment notebooks will be provided for each student in grades 2-5.

First Grade – Please REPLENISH supplies as needed through the year. Label appropriate items.
